

Inmate visitation

All inmates housed in the Lafayette County Detention Center are afforded the right to receive visits.

Visiting Schedule: Begins at 1:00 p.m. and ends at 4:30 p.m. each weekday, Monday through Friday. There will be no visitation on recognized holidays and/or weekends. All visitations will be done in a quiet and orderly fashion. Failure to follow this directive will result in the visitor being removed from the visitation list and barred from the premises. Failure to follow this directive by the inmate will result in the suspension of visitation privileges and possibly disciplinary action. This schedule may be changed or altered at any time as reason warrants by the Jail Administrator and/or the Sheriff.

Frequency of visitation: Each inmate, having completed the required paperwork and placed in general population, may have one visit of up to thirty minutes per week. Visits may not be divided into sections. One visit means one visit of any length. Qualifications for a new visit start over each Monday. Visits may be restricted at anytime due to disciplinary reasons or reasons that affect the safety and security of the facility.

Qualifications as a regular visitor: An Inmate desiring to have regular visitors must submit a list of proposed visitors to the staff. This list shall not contain more than six names. The staff shall perform a background check on this list to see if all are acceptable as visitors. Each visitor shall be over the age of twelve years and possess a valid ID on their person. Each visitor must sign in at the reception window and present his/her picture ID. Each inmate may have up to three visitors in the visiting area at one time, due to each inmate only having one seat and one phone. Only qualified visitors will be allowed to stay in the lobby or in visitation. There shall be no cell phones allowed in the visiting area. They should be left in the visitor's car or in the lockers provided in the lobby.

Commissary: Monies will be collected and receipted at the reception window. The maximum amount in the inmates account at any time is \$500. Money orders may also be mailed to the inmate. Money orders are to be made out to the inmate.
