The C.R.A.S.E. training is designed to increase your chances of surviving an active shooter event or other critical incident.

The C.R.A.S.E. course is designed and built around the "Avoid, Deny, Defend" strategy developed by ALERRT. The course will provide strategies, guidance and a proven plan and prevalence of active shooter events, civilian response options, medical issues, and considerations for conducting drills.

The C.R.A.S.E. course utilizes a Power Point presentation along with an instructor led question and answer session and is geared toward **Churches, Businesses, and Public Organizations.**
