Dear Mr. Veteran:

This letter certifies that the records of the Department of Veterans Affairs disclose that you receive VA service-connected compensation benefits at the 100% permanently and totally disabled rate.

This letter is being issued so you may apply for the following State of Mississippi benefits, as provided by State statute, for veterans receiving VA service-connected compensation benefits at the 100% permanently and totally disabled rate:

- * **Car Tag;**
- * **Ad Valorem Property Tax Exemption; AND**
- * **Hunting and Fishing Privileges.**

You may apply for a car tag at the office of your county tax collector. Exemption from the ad valorem tax is handled by your county tax assessor's office.

The State of Mississippi allows veterans receiving VA service-connected compensation benefits at the 100% permanently and totally disabled rate to fish or hunt without a license. You may use this letter as proof of your eligibility for this state benefit. However, as is required for a license, you must have this letter in your possession anytime you are fishing or hunting, and you must abide by all other state laws and regulations relating to hunting and fishing privileges. It is our intent to issue this letter only once.

Offices providing these State benefits should document their records for future reference to show that you are a veteran receiving VA service connected compensation benefits at the 100% permanently and totally disabled rate. Should you lose this letter, or if your county tax collector requires re-verification, you may ask our office for a replacement by calling toll-free 1-800-827-1000.
